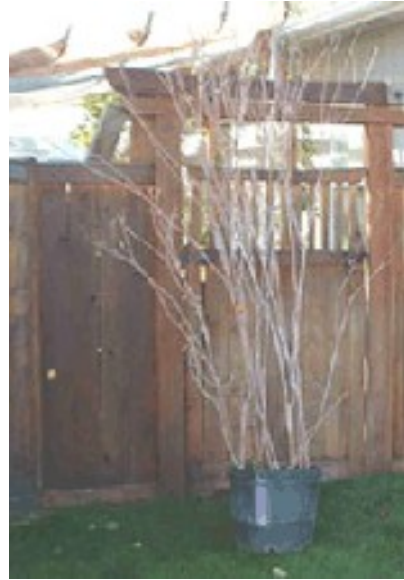


# Repotting a Vine Maple

The Vine Maple as purchased.

It is over 9 feet tall in a 10-gallon nursery container.



This is the trunk detail before repotting, showing some variation in thickness.



The tree beside the box that it will be repotted into on October 26, 2003.



The bottom of the root ball after partial root washing and trimming to make it shallower.

The cluster of trees is really a clump that sprouted from a larger downed trunk or stem.



The clump after repotting into the box.

It has been cut to 5 feet tall for ease of storage and transport.
